

## **The Saint Andrews' Chapel at Mountainside United Church**

The St. Andrews' Chapel was constructed in 1984 at the time of the amalgamation of Dominion-Douglas Church with St. Andrews Church. It very closely duplicated the existing chapel at St. Andrews. The style was distinctly contemporary with stained glass windows designed and executed in the Montreal studio of Theo Lubbers. The four tapestry wall hangings were created by Hedda Lubbers, a painter and textile artist in her own right. The suspended wooden ceiling was made as a replica of the ceiling of St. Andrews' sanctuary and hanging from it is the original chandelier moved from the first chapel. The red carpet was chosen to be reminiscent of the St Andrews' décor. As we gather in the St. Andrews' Chapel for worship in the summer we remember one of our heritage congregations.
